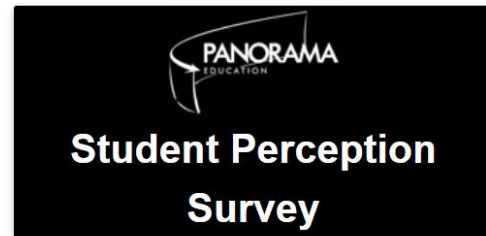

- Step 2: Click on the blue button that says "Login to Clever"



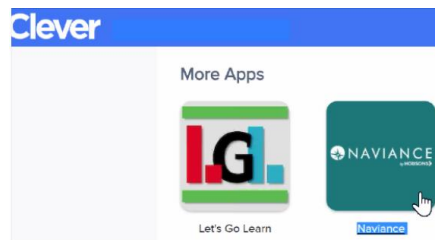

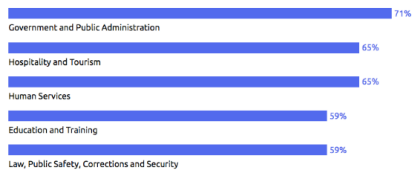

### Job Description

Repair, install or maintain mobile or stationary radio transmitting, broadcasting, and receiving equipment, cellular telecommunications, mobile broadband, ship-to-shore, aircraft-to-ground communications, and radio. May test and analyze network coverage.

#### Realistic

Realistic occupations frequently involve work activities that include practical, hands-on problems and solutions. They often deal with plants, animals, and real-world materials like wood, tools, and machinery. Many of the occupations require working outside, and do not involve a lot of paperwork or working closely with others.

#### Conventional

Conventional occupations frequently involve following set procedures and routines. These occupations can include working with data and details more than with ideas. Usually there is a clear line of authority to follow.

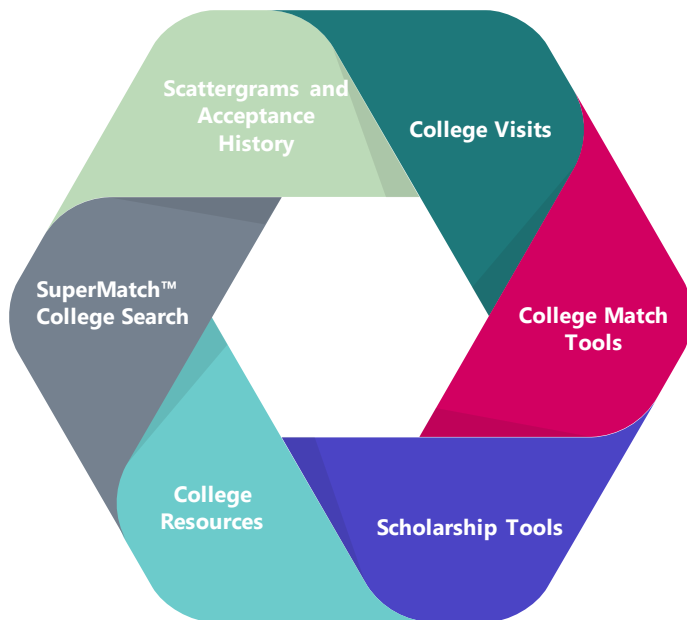
